

1. After you find the words that rhyme, ask, "How do these words look alike?"
2. Make a list of all the rhyming words. Add some other words that rhyme with "tree." They can even be silly ones!
3. Take turns reading the book, one page at a time.

Especially for older readers:

1. Practice counting to 5 by counting the animals in each tree.
2. Read the book with your child joining in.

Especially for younger readers:



1. Compare these trees with the ones in your neighborhood.
2. Talk about what kind of tree you would like to have in your yard.
3. Draw your ideal tree on the front of this bookmark.
4. Listen for words that rhyme with "tree." Can you find all 8 of them in this book?
5. Can you remember the names of all 11 animals in this book?
